# BCI Asia celebrates 10 years of recognizing Top 10 architecture firms and property developers

## Top 10 Architecture Firms and Property Developers

For the 10<sup>th</sup> year, BCI Asia names Malaysia's 10 most-active architecture firms and property developers to receive the BCI Asia Top 10 Awards at the annual BCI Asia Awards ceremony held on 13 June 2014 at the Mandarin Oriental Kuala Lumpur.

The portfolios of these elite architecture firms contain USD 3721 million worth of properties scheduled to start construction in Malaysia last year while the portfolios of these top developers contain USD 2653 million.



## **Recognising Green**

Since 2013, BCI Asia has decided to expand and reposition the meaning of the Top 10 Awards to focus on sustainability. The winners were identified as the firms with the greatest aggregate value of projects under construction during the last full calendar year by the extent of their sustainability efforts and Green building ratings (as established by BCI Asia's comprehensive project leads research and confirmed Green building rating tools).
